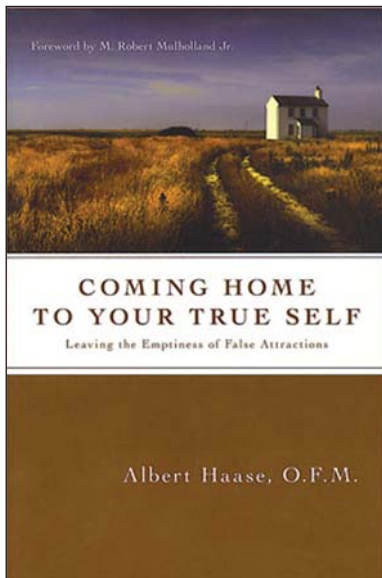


Northwest DuPage Quest...

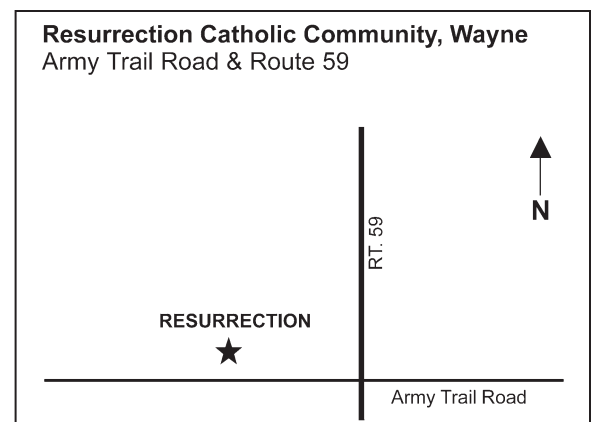
